Premises

Although we do a lot of work in the community itself, we have an urgent need for a premises for our headquarters to be based from. We need a safe place to store donations, pack grocery packs and to have our free clothing store run from.

- Property around Cosmo City/ Kya Sands area that is safe yet close to distressed communities
- Monetary donations towards renting such a property
- Monetary donations towards staffing needs
- Fitting the free clothing store with rails and racks once a sufficient premises is found
- Office furniture

Food Projects

Our grocery outreaches are the projects in which we connect with the community and get to identify their needs. There is no use for teaching a man to fish if you do not make sure he has food to sustain him while he learns. Please contact us for dates as our grocery packs are distributed on a monthly basis.

- Non-perishable food such as maize meal, canned foods, soup powders, rice, pasta etc.
- Perishable foods such as vegetables, and fruits
- Crisps, sweets, fruit, and snacks for children
- Blankets to add to grocery packs this winter
- A small truck or bakkie as the car we are currently lending for this outreach is reaching it's end
- 3 outdoor foldable trolleys- the groceries are very heavy and volunteers carry them a far distance to recipients

CV Creation

We not only believe in helping people by feeding them but also empowering them to find their own jobs. The CV Creation and coming Free Clothing Store will work hand in hand to empower persons to create a sustainable income for themselves.

- Laptops to type out CV's
- Printers, ink, paper and Photostat machines or access to them to print the finished CV's for beneficiaries

Christmas Boxes

Each Christmas thousands of children wake up to the hope of a Christmas present and find nothing as their parents simply can't afford to buy them anything. We aim to bring Christmas to as many children as possible by providing the parents with gifts to give to the children- as if they had bought them- which stimulates family relationships.

- Shoe boxes filled with 1 age appropriate toy and sweets to the total value of R80
- Sweets, toys, boxes, wrapping paper to make up our own
